HOW TO JOIN the Go Green Recycling Program?

1



Consolidate the used milk bottles, sippy cups or straw bottles that your child is no longer using.

2



Wash and clean them thoroughly, while separating the recyclables from the non-recyclables.

Note: Only the plastic parts are recyclable, while the silicone parts such as teat, spout, straw and gasket are not recyclable.

3



Bring the cleaned recyclable parts to the participating preschool, where the Pigeon recycling bin is located

4



Drop the cleaned recyclable parts into Pigeon recycling bin.

5



Your used bottles and cups are now ready to be collected by our Go Green ambassadors to send to our recycling partner for recycling.

QUESTIONS?

Q: Can I bring any brand of the milk bottles, sippy cups and straw bottles for this recycling program?

Any Brand



A: Yes, we accept all brands of the above used items, so long as they are properly washed and cleaned prior to dropping off at Preschool.

Q: What are considered the recyclable parts vs. non-recyclable parts? Why do I need to separate them?

NON-RECYCLABLE

A: Not all parts of the milk bottles, sippy cups and straw bottles can be recycled, and only the

plastic parts such as the bottles container, caps, hoods and handles can be recycled. For other parts made of silicone, such as the teat, spout, and straw, or the fabric strap attached to straw bottles, these cannot be recycled. We appreciate your kind assistance to help us separate them first to ensure a smooth recycling process at our recycling partner's facility.

Q: Why plastic waste is bad in Singapore?

A: In Singapore, about 700 million kg of plastic waste is discarded every year. But less than 10% of plastics are being recycled. Our excessive use of plastics is impacting ocean health and biodiversity. By 2050, there could be more plastics in the ocean than fish by weight.
