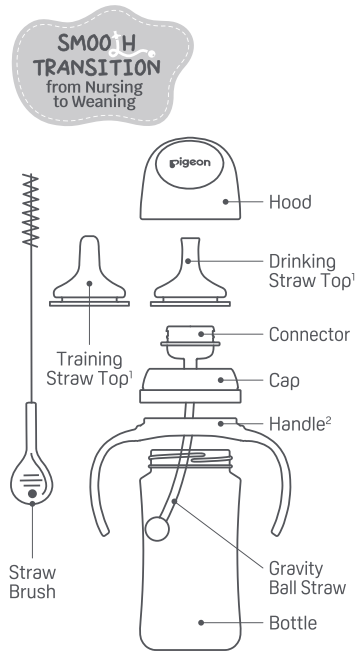

SofTouch™ Straw Set



Compatibility:

- ¹ Training/ Drinking Straw Top with Gravity Ball Straw are compatible with all Pigeon SofTouch™ 240ml Nursing Bottles.
- ² Handle is compatible with all Pigeon SofTouch™ 240ml & 330ml Nursing Bottles with the exception of all Glass bottles.

How to Assemble:

- Ventilation Valve**
Before assembly, inspect the Training/ Drinking Straw Top. Press on both ventilation valves with your finger to check that they are open.
- Grasp the shield of the Training/ Drinking Straw Top firmly.
- Place over the cap, then press down to fit it securely into the cap. Ensure that the shield is not too loose, and the valves can still be opened.
- Attach the tube of the Gravity Ball Straw to the base of the Connector.
- Next, insert the Connector with Gravity Ball Straw (attached in Step 4) into the Straw Top that has been fitted into the Cap (in Step 3). Ensure that all straw parts are securely assembled.
- Assemble the Bottle Handle onto the Nursing Bottle.



Screw on the Cap to complete assembly. Proper assembly is necessary to ensure a leak-free experience.

Usage Tips:



For replacement Training/ Drinking Straw Set: Trimming of the straw may be required depending on the material type and volume of your bottle. Please trim according to the cutting guide printed on the packaging.



To disassemble the Gravity Ball Straw, lightly press on the flat part of the Connector with your thumb, and push outwards.



If your baby is drinking in a lying down position, turn the bottle upside down and give it a light shake to allow the Gravity Ball to drop. This would allow for a smoother drinking experience.

Warning: Straw bottles are to be used to feed your baby with milk or other liquids. Do not use them for any other purpose.

For safety and hygiene reasons, replace the Straw Tops every 2 months to maintain optimal condition of the Straw Tops.

Before First Use

Before first use, disassemble the product and clean thoroughly. Then, place all components in boiling water for 5 minutes. This is to ensure hygiene. Always wash your hands with soap before cleaning, sterilizing and feeding.

Cleaning & Storage Instructions

After each use, wash thoroughly and sterilize.

- Ensure that all parts including areas which may not be visible are thoroughly washed and rinsed to remove any milk residues.
- Disassemble and clean the product thoroughly as per the following to ensure hygiene.

a. For Bottle

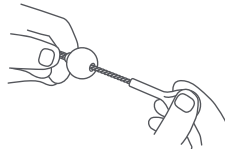
- Immediately after use, rinse in warm water and wash using Pigeon Liquid Cleanser. Use a nylon brush to wash glass bottles. Use a sponge brush to wash plastic bottles.
- Abrasive scrubbing brushes, metal scrubbing brushes and abrasive cleansers should be avoided as they may cause scratches on the bottle.

b. For Training/ Drinking Straw Tops and Gravity Ball Straw

- Disassemble all components (Training/ Drinking Straw Top, Connector and Gravity Ball Straw) and wash using Pigeon Liquid Cleanser.
- Use your fingers to gently massage around the straw's opening, valve, and ventilation valve to clean. If you scrub or pull too hard, the valve may get damaged which can cause leaks.



- For more targeted cleaning of the Straw Top, gently clean the inside and the tip of the straw with SofTouch™ Nipple Brush. You may place your finger at the tip of the Straw Top to ensure that the nipple brush does not break through the tip as that could damage the valve.
- Clean the insides of the Gravity Ball Straw using SofTouch™ Straw Brush for Gravity Ball Straw. Insert the straw brush into the base of the straw. Move back & forth gently to remove any stains/ residue.



- Rinse with warm water and dry thoroughly.
- Caution:**
 - To protect the ventilation valve and straw opening, a white powdered food additive has been applied. Before using for the first time, wash thoroughly.
 - Inspect before each use and pull the Straw Top in all direction. The Straw Top may be worn by biting. Special attention is needed for a teething child. Throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
 - Do not use sharp tools to clean the ventilation valve, straw opening and gravity ball straw as they may get torn and result in leakage.
 - Do not use a dish-drying machine.

- Do not clean with abrasive cleaning agents.

c. For Handle

- Wash using Pigeon Liquid Cleanser, rinse with warm water and dry thoroughly.

Sterilization Instructions

Be sure to sterilize before every use.

Boiling Sterilization: Place all parts in boiling water for 5 minutes.

Steam Sterilization: You can use Pigeon Steam Sterilizer and follow the directions in the user manual.

UV* Sterilization is possible. **Chemical Sterilization** is possible for all parts except the Gravity Ball Straw. Use sterilization products made specifically for baby bottles and nipples. Follow the instructions in the user's manual for these products. With chemical sterilization, the printing on the bottle may fade.

Caution:

- It is recommended to replace the product when it starts to discolour and/ or turn cloudy.
- **Do NOT** sterilize or heat the Gravity Ball Straw in a microwave oven.
- After boiling sterilization, the bottle will be hot. Be careful not to burn yourself.
- All grease or oil residue should be thoroughly removed before sterilising to avoid permanent staining of parts

Breastmilk Preparation

Pour thawed breastmilk into the bottle and warm it up. For easy and convenient warming, use Pigeon Smart Bottle Warmer set at 37°C.

For your child's safety and health WARNING!

- Continuous and prolonged sucking of fluids will cause tooth decay.
- Always check food temperature before feeding.
- Throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
- Keep all components not in use out of the reach of children.
- Never attach to cords, ribbons, laces or loose parts of clothing. The child can be strangled.
- Never use a straw top as a soother.
- Always use this product with adult supervision.
- Straws are not suitable for a child under 6 months.
- Do not use a microwave to warm contents as this may cause uneven heating. Localised high temperatures could scald your baby.
- The straw top may be worn by biting. Special attention is needed for a teething child.
- Do not leave the straws in direct sunlight or heat, or leave in disinfectant ("sterilizing solution") for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the straws.
- When not in use, keep in a dry, covered container.
- Avoid putting boiling water or carbonated liquids in this bottle as the air pressure inside the bottle will increase and water may gush out from the tip of the straw and cause burns.
